



The Mat-Su Borough School District, in conjunction with the Division of Public Health and the Department of Health & Social Services, will be holding H1N1 Mass Dispensing Clinics.

The vaccines are entirely voluntary and the clinics are being offered as a service to Mat-Su Borough families.

Dates: November 14, November 21, and December 12 (all on Saturdays)

Times: 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. (all days)

Location: Colony High School

Who may be vaccinated at these clinics:

Only enrolled students of the MSBSD (no staff, siblings, etc.)

What you need to know:

- Students must be accompanied by a parent/guardian who will be required to sign a permission slip for the vaccination
- MSBSD student immunization records will be available through the District IT Department (shot records)
- According to the Center for Disease Control (CDC), all children ages 6 months through 9 years old need to have 2 doses of the vaccine spaced about a month apart. If your student attends the first clinic on November 14, he/she will be able to receive the second dose at the December 12 clinic

EMTs and an ambulance will be at the site on the clinic days.
