Syllabus for High School Guitar Class Level 1

Course description and objectives:

- -Stringing the guitar and care of the guitar will be taught.
- -The student will learn how to hold the guitar properly.
- -The student will learn how to play chords and single notes on the guitar using a pick and/or fingers.
- -There will be instruction on how to strum rhythms and finger pick in time.
- -The student will learn to be able to accompany singing with the guitar using a chord progression.
- -The student will also develop beginning skills in sight-reading single notes and chord symbols.
- -Basic music theory will also be taught the staff, notes, sharps, flats, naturals, accidentals, intervals, scales, keys.
- -There will be some exposure to at least 1 alternate tuning.
- -How to produce harmonic tones on the string will be taught.
- -In class there will be demonstrations given by the teacher and chosen videos for instruction and inspiration.
