- ◆ Amendments to the ILP may be requested in writing prior to the deadlines outlined in the student handbook and must be approved by the advisor
- ◆ Students who are not proficient in grades 3 -12 as measured on State (PEAKS) or District (MAP) testing, or if no testing information is available, then the ILP must identify strategies to move the student toward meeting standards in the related subject and a plan for monitoring of student progress. The minimum contact for non-proficient students is monthly and a record will be kept of this contact.
- ◆ **Grading Scale:** Grades K-3: O= Outstanding, S= Satisfactory, N= Needs Improvement  
Grades 4-12: A = 90-100%, B =80-89%, C =70-79% , D =60-69%, F =0-59%

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## Assessments by the Homeschool Teacher

The documents that the homeschool teacher will submit to the teacher/advisor to determine what grade/credit is earned for a course is listed in the table below.

For any situation where the parent does not give the grade such as BYU, APEX, eDynamic, select the category "Transcript" as the assessment. The parent will not have to enter grades for these courses on the parent portal.

<b>ASSESSMENTS</b>	<b>DEFINITION</b>
Test/Quizzes	All chapter tests and section quizzes submitted
Work Samples	Variety of assignments and daily work submitted, could include workbooks along with tests and quizzes
Log	Log of hours completed working on the course submitted i.e., PE log, performance log
Portfolio	A wide selection of documents illustrating multiple learning activities, including course portfolio and learning logs submitted
Project	A complete report of a comprehensive project submitted, such as a science fair project or art project. This can include lab notebooks, PowerPoint presentations, art projects, sewing projects, etc.
Presentation/Demonstration	A video or live presentation of the skill learned submitted, such as a short video demonstrating proper gun safety or playing the piano
Curriculum provided	A printout of the course assignments and test grades for a purchased online curriculum i.e., Acellus, Buzz, submitted
Term paper/Essays	A collection of writing samples for a course submitted
Certificate/License	A certificate earned through a course submitted i.e., drivers license, hunter safety certificate
Parent Observation	<b>Used for students K-3.</b> The parent describes the learning activities completed by the student, such as PE activities, for young children.
Transcript	A transcript from another school or district delivered course documenting grade earned. This is not submitted by parent but comes directly from the source. Examples are college courses, BYU, APEX, eDynamic. Parent will not enter grades on the parent portal.
