Statue of Liberty

This iconic statue, built in 1886 on Liberty Island and 151 feet tall, commemorates the centennial of the signing of the United States Declaration of Independence. It is a gesture of friendship from France to the U.S. *Liberty Enlightening the World* is a symbol of welcoming immigrants to the U.S. and is listed as a World Heritage Site. Ellis Island, where 12 million immigrants entering the U.S. passed through, is included in the monument.
